On Tuesday April 29, high school students in the Lanark region tested their environmental smarts for the opportunity to compete at the Ontario Envirothon Championships. Carleton Place High School won the Lanark Regional Envirothon Competition and will advance to the Ontario Envirothon Championships to be held May 7 to 10 at Tim Horton Onondaga Farms in St. George, ON.
