Belleville, May 19, 2008 - At the Ontario Municipal Water Association's recent annual general meeting in London, Nick Benkovich, Director of Water & Wastewater Services for the City of Greater Sudbury, was elected OMWA's 2008 President.

She has provided strong and principled leadership to our board in her own unique style and will surely be a tough act to follow", said Nick Benkovich.

Nick is the past recipient of the OMWA Award for Exceptional Merit for 2006 (presented annually for exceptional service to the OMWA and the waterworks industry) and the Don Black Award in 2007 (presented annually in recognition of outstanding and dedicated service to the principles of the Ontario Municipal Water Association).
