About the Oak Ridges Moraine

The Oak Ridges Moraine Foundation was created in 2002 to help protect, preserve and restore the Oak Ridges Moraine, part of Ontario's Greenbelt and one of Ontario's most prominent geological landforms, extending 160 kilometers across southern Ontario, from the Trent River to the Niagara Escarpment.

It has long been recognized for its importance as wildlife habitat and a source of groundwater. It is the starting point of the 65 rivers flowing into Lake Ontario, Lake Simcoe and the Kawartha Lakes, and is the source of drinking water for over 250,000 people.

Since its inception, the Oak Ridges Moraine Foundation has helped to restore more than 800 acres of significant land through tree planting, stream rehabilitation, wetland enhancement and prairie restoration.
