



## Oak Ridges Moraine Foundation celebrates funding milestone \$46 million goes into preserving the Oak Ridges Moraine

(Toronto, October 6, 2008) The Oak Ridges Moraine Foundation (ORMF) is thrilled to announce the allocation of grants totaling \$13 million dollars to 148 conservation projects across the Moraine. This funding has been leveraged by an additional \$33 million, making the total funding impact an astounding \$46 million.

Stretching 160 kilometers from the Trent River to the Niagara Escarpment, the **Oak Ridges Moraine** has long been recognized for its importance as wildlife habitat and a source of groundwater.
