Camp Manitou is located 8 miles west of Whitefish Falls. The La Cloche Mountains provide a wonderful backdrop for the camp, which fronts on the North Channel of Lake Huron. The setting is rustic yet majestic. Leaders and youth have been sharing summer camping experiences here since the 1920's.

Programs take place in a friendly Christian atmosphere and include camp fires, swimming, hiking, canoeing, crafts, and fellowship. Physical facilities include ten sleep cabins, a main lodge and dining hall, canoes and kayaks, a sauna, an outdoor chapel, tennis and basketball courts, a ball field, hiking trails, an excellent sandy swimming area, outdoor privies, wood/solar shower house, and solar powered lights. Skilled and enthusiastic volunteers provide leadership for youth and family camp programs.
