Government of Newfoundland and Labrador to be investigated for violation of federal PCB regulations

Allan Williams of New Harbour, Newfoundland, is successful in using his environmental rights to request a federal investigation of alleged violations of the federal PCB regulation under the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999*. The circumstances that have led to the PCB contamination of the landfill primarily result from disposal of transformer casings that took place in 1985 and then again in 1994 in a remediation project.

Mr. Williams is available to discuss the following points:

- Circumstances leading to the PCB contamination and inadequate action by the Province and their consultants
- Circumstances that lead to filing an application for investigation
- The application process, and the speed with which this investigation is being addressed
