

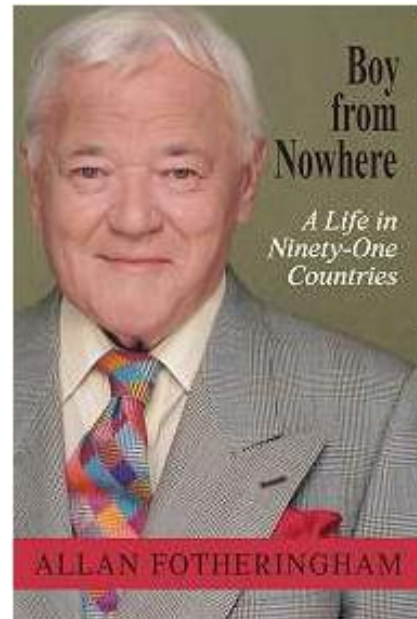

Renowned Canadian journalist launches autobiography in Canadian cities this month

Allan Fotheringham, the journalist that *Time* magazine once described as “Canada’s most consistently controversial newspaper columnist,” will be releasing his autobiography this month.

The book is titled “Boy From Nowhere: A life in Ninety-One Countries,” and covers Fotheringham’s career as a journalist and columnist for the Vancouver Sun, Toronto Sun, Globe and Mail, panellist on CBC-TV’s Front Page Challenge, and, most notably, his almost three-plus decades of writing with Maclean’s magazine. The book also describes his meetings with renowned personalities Robert F. Kennedy, Ronald Reagan, The Beatles, Pierre Trudeau, and Nelson Mandela, to name a few.
