Deadline: December 16, 2013

Length: Maximum of 500 words

Specifications: The abstract proposal should include a description of the proposed presentation, results/conclusions, and the technical category most applicable to your abstract from the list of topics. Please supply full details of author/presenter.

If Successful: Authors whose abstract proposals are accepted will be required to provide the abstract for inclusion in the conference proceedings along with a PowerPoint presentation. Full details will be supplied to authors after the selection process is completed at the end of December 2013.

Please note: If you would like to submit more than one abstract please submit each abstract as a separate document.

Note to Authors:

Before submitting an abstract please ensure you have the necessary permissions from your line management to submit and present and also the agreement of any companies/persons whose material you may be including or referring to in the presentation. It is your responsibility to ensure that you have the necessary permissions in place in advance.
