## Environmental Commissioner of Ontario to release special report on province's waste strategy

Dianne Saxe, Environmental Commissioner of Ontario, will release a special report that reviews the provincial government's ambitious new *Waste-Free Ontario Act, 2016*.

The report examines key questions, including:

- What is Ontario's vision for a waste-free future?
- What are the key lessons from Ontario's first 40 years of waste diversion?
- What's different about the new plan, and what will the *Waste-Free Ontario Act, 2016* change?
- What are the key challenges in implementing the new law?
